

Point Score Rules PUPPY

1. The competition is open to all members of the Basenji Club of NSW Inc.
 2. The Competition is open to all puppies between three and twelve months of age.
 3. The competition will be run as one division, with a Best and a one Opposite Sex Winner.
 4. The competition will be run from the The Hound Club Winter Show or the 1st of October until the Sydney Royal, for all Championship shows in NSW & the ACT.
 5. The Puppies must be entered in any class for puppies under twelve months Being classes 1,1A, or 2,2A or 3,3A classes to be eligible.
 6. There will be eight club nominated shows and six member nominated shows. Member nominated shows will be the best result obtained within the month, excluding the club nominated show; ie each month from October to judging at the Sydney Royal there will be one club nominated show and one member nominated show. Excluding the month of April being the Sydney Royal, where only the club nominated show will be included in the results and tally.
- In the month of October where the Hound club of NSW winter show and the BCONSW Championship show are held in the same month, we will conduct two club nominated shows in the month.
8. Should the Sydney Royal fall into the month of March, that month will see two club nominated shows.
 9. Club nominated shows will be selected at the club AGM. Puppies must be exhibited at, least two club nominated shows to be eligible for the competition.
 10. Points will be awarded as follows: -

Club nominated shows:

1st placing 5 points

2nd placing 4 points

3rd placing 3 points

4th placing 2 points

5th placing 1 point

At a designated Puppy Point Score Show, should placings not be awarded 1 to 5, points will only be allocated as per the judge's placings, i.e. 3,2,1. "

At Club nominated Point Score Shows, it is the duty of exhibitors participating in the Puppy Point Score competition, to advise the Ring Steward to request that the judge place exhibits 1 to 5 (if required) in each of the Puppy Classes

Member nominated show:

1st placing 3 points

2nd placing 2 points

3rd placing 1 points

The Winner of a class run off will be award points including both sexes. A puppy must have beaten the equivalent number of puppies to attain maximum points: ie to qualify for five points there must be at least 5 puppies, dogs and bitches. An automatic (only exhibit in class present) 1st placing will earn 1 point.

11. In event of two or more basenji puppies finishing with equal points, the placings at the Sydney Royal will decide the winner. Should neither of the puppies be placed at the Sydney Royal a count back will take place on the number of placings: ie number of 5 point 1st placings, then 4 point placings, then 3 point 3rd placings etc.

12. The awards will be presented to the registered owner of the puppy at the completion of the competition.

13. There will be no alterations or amendments to the rules while the competition is in progress.

14. Results will be compiled from results published in the Basenji News. Points will not be accepted for shows that are not submitted for publication within the month following the show.

15. The Basenji Club of Victoria Championship show can be included as a member nominated result. The competition is open to all members of the Basenji Club of NSW Inc.
